Existing members

Cubs, Scouts, Ventures and Rovers will meet in Larch Hill on Friday evening at 5pm. The cost for the weekend is €30.

Beavers will come up on Saturday at 10.00am and their cost will be \in 15. Beavers should bring a packed lunch with them for Saturday.

The cost for the weekend covers all meals, activities and camping fees.

Collection time for everyone will be 1pm on Sunday. Please meet and collect from the *main Carpark* in Larch Hill.

New members

Our Cubs and Scouts who are new to the Group this year can come up for the day on Saturday from 10am - 7pm and the cost of this is ≤ 10 , lunch and dinner will be provided.

Our new Beavers can come up on Saturday afternoon from 1pm – 5pm at no charge but you must bring a packed lunch. Again please meet and collect from the main Carpark in Larch Hill. (see reverse for info on what to bring and how to get there).

If your child needs to take any medication over the period of the camp the medication should be put into a clear plastic bag with your childs name on it and given to the leaders on arrival in Larch Hill. You will be required to complete a separate form.

Gear List

Warm Sleepwear

Information for our new Beavers, Cubs & Scouts

What to bring for a day trip

Each person should wear waterproof comfortable boots or shoes. You should also have a warm waterproof jacket, waterproof trousers and a full change of clothes in a plastic bag in a small backpack that you can carry by yourself. Your name should also be on all items.

Direction to Larch Hill – more info & maps available from www.larchhill.org

From the M50 motorway to Larch Hill Leave the M50 motorway at Junction 12 and follow signs for Ballyboden. At first roundabout take 2nd exit, at next roundabout take 2nd exit, at next roundabout take 3rd exit drive up Ballyboden Road past the Eastern Health Board Health Centre and continue up this road past Edmondstown Golf Club. You will pass under the motorway bridge and come to The Merry Ploughboy Pub on your left. About 200 metres further on there is a fork in the road take the left turn, down the hill. At the foot of the dip you will come to a junction with Mutton Lane, carefully cross the junction onto Mutton Lane. Drive along Mutton Lane, ignoring side roads, and you will arrive at the main gates in a cul-de-sac.
